FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What will be covered?

- A brief tour of the Print Studio.
- An introduction to using the GOCCOPRO equipment and how to transfer an image onto mesh to then screen print.

What should I bring?

- Up to three photographic images that want to use in your art work. It is preferable if these images are already digitally amended and grey-scaled.
- Or hand drawn images that can be scanned.
- There will also be a selection of stock images that you can use for your prints.

What should I wear?

- Plastic aprons are provided but we'd recommend also wearing old clothes – printmaking can be messy!
- Please note that open-toed shoes and sandals are **not** allowed.
- Windows will be open for ventilation purposes so we recommend bringing warm layers.

What should I expect?

- The aim is to leave with an expanded knowledge of screen-printing and the confidence to build on this and experiment. Hopefully you will be pleased with your results but the main aim is to learn the skills and have fun! You will also learn how to combine these basic skills with using digitally created screens from which you can screen print with.
- You will create an edition of a screen printed image.
