Location: Print Studio, beside Jute Café bar on Lower ground level

Date: Thu from 12 May (three-week course: 12, 19 & 26 May)

Time: 18:00 - 20:30

What will be covered?

You'll learn all about the wonderful world of Risograph printing, a fast-paced process that uses soy ink and recycled paper. Print your design, choosing from our selection of bright colours, by printing one layer each week on our vintage Riso machines.

What should I bring?

A usb with a selection of images – these can be your own illustrations, photos, or logos.

What should I wear?

There are no special requirements but we'd advise wearing comfortable shoes and clothes, you'll be moving around heavy ink drums (with assistance of course!). Please note that open-toed shoes and sandals are not allowed in the Print Studio. Windows will be open for ventilation purposes so we recommend bringing warm layers.

What should I expect?

No previous art experience is needed, and having booked your place, you can simply turn up on the day.

Visiting Safely
