What will be covered?

A brief tour of the Print Studio

The basics of screen-printing:

- The technique of pulling a screen print
- Making simple paper stencils to create an image
- Using Screen Filler & Drawing Fluid to paint directly onto the screen to create more sophisticated stencils
- Working in layers

What should I bring?

You don't need to bring anything, but some ideas/inspiration may help.

What should I wear?

Aprons are provided but we'd recommend also wearing old clothes – printmaking can be messy! Please note open-toed shoes and sandals are not allowed.

What Should I Expect?

The aim is to leave with a basic knowledge of screen-printing and the confidence to build on this and experiment. Hopefully you will be pleased with your results but the main aim is to learn the skills and have fun! At the end of the course your tutor will chat about the Intermediate Screen Printing course which is a popular follow on.

No previous art experience is needed, and having booked your place, you can simply turn up on the day
