#### **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

##### **What will be covered?**

You will learn how to prepare and coat a Perspex plate, and make a design for your print using watercolour and brushes, and/or water colour pencils and crayons. You will then transfer your design onto the dampened and prepared paper, using the press.

There will be demonstrations throughout the weekend workshop, which build up a comprehensive picture of the techniques used.

##### **What should I bring?**

Images or your imagination for inspiration!

All materials will be provided but if you have them you may wish to bring your own set of watercolour paints (E.G. Winsor and Newton, Cotman), watercolour crayons (E.G. Caran d'Ache, NeoColor II), or watersoluble pencils (Stabilo). You may also want to have your own set of preferred brushes.

##### **What should I wear?**

We will provide aprons but would also recommend wearing old clothing, as printmaking can be messy. Please note that open-toed footwear and sandals are not allowed in the Print Studio.

**There will be a short session at the end of the course for feedback and discussion. You will also be offered the opportunity to give written feedback.**
