

The weather is changing and DCA Cinema is here for it, as Andrew Scott and Brendan Fraser face the forecast that determined D-Day's success in WW2 true story *Pressure*. Kerry Condon and Damian Lewis also star in this gripping drama.

Willem Dafoe stars in early autumn treat *Late Fame*, playing a postal worker whose decades-old poetry collection is "rediscovered" by a group of young artists. Plus, there are chills in acclaimed Australian horror *Leviticus*, as two teenage boys' love is threatened by their religious community and a supernatural force.

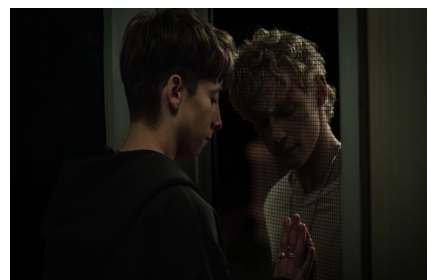
