

Nine years after the release of *Mad Max: Fury Road*, its much-anticipated follow-up, ***Furiosa: A Mad Max Saga*** arrives at DCA Cinema! We follow a young Furiosa, played by Anya Taylor-Joy, as she travels across the Wasteland, facing many trials while trying to find her way home. This gritty prequel promises to be a wild and unpredictable ride.

Elsewhere, experience acclaimed international cinema with ***Blackbird Blackbird Blackberry***, a charming Georgian drama about love and passion in later life, and ***Omen (Augure)***, a Congolese tale of suspicion and belonging. You can let Martin Scorsese be your guide to two iconic filmmakers with ***Made in England: Powell & Pressburger***, and revisit a Scottish classic with ***Trainspotting*** remastered in 4K.

You can also see a landmark work of Italian neorealism with 1945's ***Rome, Open City***, and we'll be screening ***20 Days in Mariupol + Panel Discussion*** in collaboration with Ukraine Solidarity Campaign Scotland (USCS) and the Dundee branch of the National Union of Journalists (NUJ). Finally, we begin our series of films to celebrate V&A Dundee's *Kimono* exhibition with ***Sanjuro*** on 35mm. Enjoy!
