The Descent (20th Anniversary 4K Restoration) (18, 1h40m)

Neil Marshall's tale of a caving expedition gone horribly wrong is surely one of the most claustrophobic films ever made and is now celebrated as one of the best horror films of the 2000s. We're excited to share this brand-new 4K restoration with you, which will be introduced by Dr Lucy Fife Donaldson, Senior Lecturer in Film Studies at University of St Andrews.



Return to Oz (40th Anniversary) (PG, 1h53m)

Released in 1985 as a sequel to *The Wizard of Oz*, this bizarre children's film is full of nightmare-fuel as it explores some of the darker and stranger corners of Frank L Baum's original novels. Fairuza Balk (*The Craft*) stars as Dorothy, who escapes electroshock treatment and heads back to the land of Oz, where she meets friends and enemies old and new.



Evilspeak (VHS) + short film (18, 1h37m)

Originally banned in the UK, *Evilspeak* is a good illustration of the absurdity of the 'video nasties' era. To celebrate this, we'll be screening it from an original VHS tape to add to the trashy 80s fun. With its delightfully dated computer graphics and wonderfully fun practical effects, this is one to enjoy with an audience. Screening alongside it will be short film *The Nightwalker*.
