FESTIVAL

The 2025 festival took place from Thu 8 to Sun 11 May and saw a 24% increase in admissions compared to 2024, with sales of festival passes increasing by 14%.

Dundead started in 2011 in response to demand from local horror fans. In 2021 programming for Dundead was brought in-house at DCA and the festival's popularity has grown in the years since.

The 2025 festival screened six new films alongside a retrospective strand of six vintage Italian horror titles. The festival welcomed special guests Mike Muncer of *The Evolution of Horror* podcast, writer and podcaster Becky Darke and Canadian short filmmaker Colin G Cooper. It also saw the introduction of a Green Room for festival attendees, badge making, and a collaboration with Holy Goat Brewing to create a limited-edition Dundead IPA.

HALLOWEEN

Dundead celebrated Halloween in style, with 2025's October season of screenings welcoming more horror fans than ever.

This year's six screenings saw a 14% increase in admissions on 2024, with sold-out anniversary screenings of *The Rocky Horror Picture Show* and *The Phantom of the Opera*. Highlights included drag performances from CLIMAX Dundee, a preview of a new 4K Restoration of *The Descent* introduced by Dr Lucy Fife Donaldson (Senior Lecturer in Film Studies at University of St Andrews) and *Evilspeak* screened from an original VHS.

DUNDEAD PRESENTS THE PHANTOM OF THE OPERA ON TOUR

As part of Dundead Halloween and to mark *The Phantom of the Opera*'s 100th anniversary, Dundead commissioned a new score by acclaimed Scottish composers Andrew Wasylyk and Tommy Perman.

The event toured five cinemas across Scotland, including a sold-out screening at DCA on Halloween itself. This was made possible thanks to support by Film Hub Scotland, part of the BFI's Film Audience Network, awarding funding on behalf of Screen Scotland and the BFI National Lottery.

MONTHLY SCREENINGS

Dundead continues all year round.

In addition to the May festival and October Halloween screenings, 13 Dundead screenings took place across the year. These saw an increase in attendance of 20% on 2024 - the first full year of regular monthly screenings.

DUNDEAD AUDIENCE

In 2025 Dundead attracted new visitors to DCA as well as building on its loyal fan base.

Across the year 22% of Dundead bookers were first time visitors to DCA. 33% of bookers came along to more than one Dundead screening, with 50 individuals coming to 10 or more screenings across the year.
