Join us this week for *Anora*, the winner of the Palme d'Or at this year's Cannes film festival. This drama from Sean Baker (*The Florida Project*) follows a young sex worker (an Oscar-tipped Mikey Madison) who impulsively marries the son of an oligarch.

For more great performances, don't miss *Heretic*, a chilling thriller starring Hugh Grant. See Pedro Almodóvar's *The Room Next Door*, along with documentaries *Super/Man: The Christopher Reeve Story*, Exhibition on Screen: *Van Gogh: Poets & Lovers* and *Mogwai: If the Stars Had a Sound + Q&A*.

Explore the story of artist Wilhelmina Barns-Graham in *A Sudden Glimpse to Deeper Things* – we'll welcome director Mark Cousins to DCA on Saturday for a post-screening Q&A. On Sunday, enjoy a celebration of celluloid, with *Cinema Paradiso* (35mm), *Splice Here: A Projected Odyssey* and *Inglourious Basterds* (35mm).

It's the last weekend of **Discovery Film Festival!** We're screening **Shorts for Wee Ones** and **Families**, along with animated feature **Nina and the Hedgehog's Secret** and drama **Sisterhood** for older teens. Anora (18, 2h19m)

Mikey Madison (*Scream*, 2022) stars as a sex worker from Brooklyn who impulsively marries a gangster's son, causing chaos to unfold.

Heretic (15, 1h50m)

Two young missionaries are forced to prove their faith in a twisted game in this psychological horror featuring Hugh Grant as the villain.



The Room Next Door (12A, 2h10m)

Spanish director Pedro Almodóvar returns with this contemplative drama about two friends who reconnect in an extreme situation.

A Sudden Glimpse to Deeper Things (PG, 1h28m)

This feature documentary tells the story of Wilhemina Barns-Graham, the remakable Scottish painter born and raised in St Andrews.

The Walk (10+, 1h20m)

This remarkable documentary follows the giant puppet Amal as she travels across Europe, highlighting the plight of child refugees. Join us after the film for a Puppetry Workshop with Temporary Commons.
