Dundead Halloween brings you a special selection of six films to enjoy throughout October. Join us for horror classics, forgotten gems, and a surprise preview.

We begin the scares with a cross-over event: David Lynch's debut film *Eraserhead* will be showing as part of Dundead Halloween and our Surrealism on Film season. Then we're keeping things mysterious with a **Surprise Preview** - do you dare step into the unknown? The classic horrors continue with a 4K restoration of 1976's *Carrie* and the lesser-known-but-very-fun *Pumpkinhead* from 1988. We're also very excited to be showing *Hollywood 90028*, a film from 1972 that was thought lost and has now been lovingly restored.

Our last screening will happen on All Hallows Eve itself. Join us on 31 October for our 40th anniversary screening of *A Nightmare on Elm Street* and come along in costume for your chance to win a Dundead goody bag.

Eraserhead (15, 1h29m)

David Lynch's 1977 debut feature is confounding, mysterious and melancholic. Shot in black and white over a course of four years, it tells the tale of Henry Spencer, who has to care for his strange, monstrous baby. Showing as part of Dundead Halloween and DCA's Surrealism on Film season, this screening will be introduced by Michael Coull, Dundead programmer.



Surprise Preview (tbc, tbc)

Dare to be scared with our Dundead Halloween surprise screening! Will it be a trick or a treat? We're keeping this one under wraps until you're seated in the cinema, but you can expect a preview of something brand-new, specially selected by Dundead programmer Michael Coull. 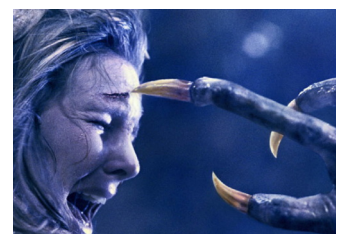
Carrie (4K Restoration) (18, 1h38m)

Based on the book by Stephen King, Brian De Palma's *Carrie* was a critical and commercial success on release and remains hugely influential today - it's nearly impossible to watch a prom scene in any kind of media and not think of this film. Sissy Spacek gives an unforgettable performance as the teenage girl who discovers she had telekinetic powers, with deadly consequences.



Pumpkinhead (18, 1h26m)

Legendary effects artist Stan Winston (*Jurassic Park*, *Aliens*) made his directorial debut with this undersung 1988 gem about vengeance, Faustian bargains and a giant rampaging monster called Pumpkinhead. The film, a mainstay in video rental stores, has gained a cult following over the years, but still feels under-appreciated. For fun, spooky, 80s Halloween thrills, this is as good as it gets.

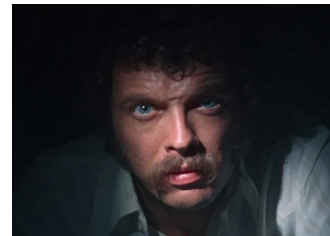

Hollywood 90028 (NC18, 1h30m)

This 1974 film by Christina Hornisher was thought lost, until Grindhouse Releasing's Bob Murawski's relentless pursuit saw it tracked down and restored. It follows a young photographer who makes a living shooting porn films and spends his free time murdering women. We're delighted that this screening will feature a recorded introduction by programmer, journalist and film historian Heidi Honeycutt.



A Nightmare on Elm Street (40th Anniversary) (15, 1h31m)

Before he reinvented the slasher genre for the second time with 1996's *Scream* (already seen on DCA screens earlier in the year), Wes Craven took his first stab at the genre with 1984's *A Nightmare on Elm Street*. The film introduced us to the horror icon Freddy (or 'Fred' as he's referred to here) Krueger, played by Robert Englund, the child-murdering ex-janitor who tracks his victims down in their sleep.
