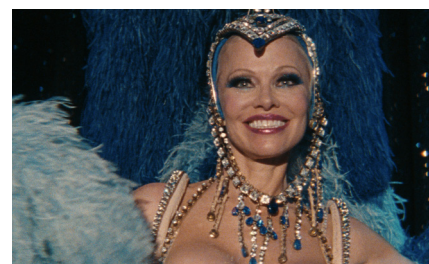
A unique sci-fi comedy from Bong Joon-ho (*Parasite*), which sees Robert Pattinson star as a clone worker who must die for a living.
