Elsewhere, there are a variety of vintage features screening this week, from a 4K restoration of screwball comedy **His Girl Friday**, to the new 'ultimate cut' of controversial 1979 Roman drama **Caligula**, and a 60th anniversary **Dundead** screening of **Onibaba**, the Japanese horror named "one of the most terrifying films I've ever seen" by the director of *The Exorcist*.

There are more chances to see **Beetlejuice Beetlejuice** and Jodie Comer stars in award-winning play **NT Live: Prima Facie**. We're also delighted to share two more films from our **Women Hold Up the Sky** season in partnership with **Mint Chinese Film Festival** and **Aya Films**: stunning 1927 silent film **Xi Xiang Ji**, accompanied by a live music score from Edinburgh composer and harpist Aurora Engine, and family drama **Yangzi's Confusion**. 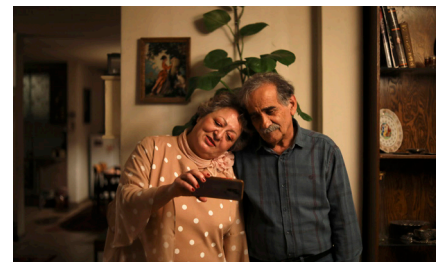
