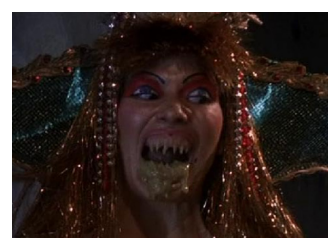
Dumplings

There's a formidable villainess at the heart of this gloriously pulpy luchador film.



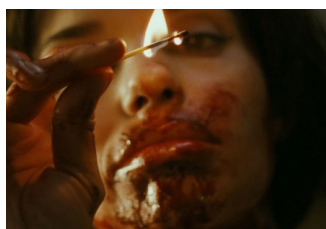

Julia Ducournau's electrifying debut is both a brilliant coming of age story and a genuinely subversive feminist horror.



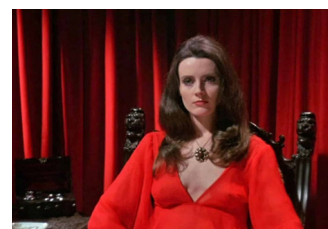
Trouble Every Day

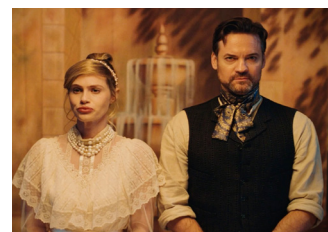
Camp
